They cried out against Him, and determined to take His life. **{SJ 56.6}**

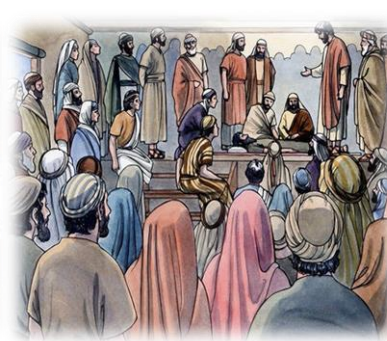
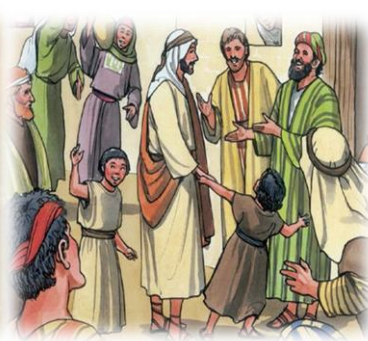
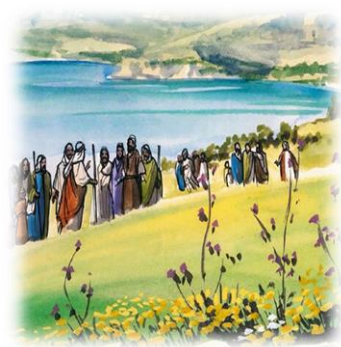
They hurried Him away, meaning to throw Him over the steep side of a hill.

Nature Electricity and Water

About 20 percent of the world's electrical power is made through the use of water.

Hydroelectric power plants are less expensive to operate than other types of plants, and they do not pollute the air. Because of the limit of water in some areas and countries, hydroelectric power plants can not be used.

So, next time you turn on your electricity think how the water had a part in bringing it to you. It is like another miracle each time we can turn on a light, run the vacuum or saw, or wash our clothes. It can remind us of Christ's first miracle at the wedding feast. How He wants to perform a miracle in your life, helping you to overcome every sin—He will give you the power!



It is no less of a miracle than He performed at Cana that Jesus sends rainwater for the grapevine and changes it into delicious juice. He is continually performing miracles to supply our needs. Try to realize this when you open a bottle (like a store jar) of juice. He created that juice especially for you. Thus, every meal is truly a sacrament.



Remarkable Parent Food

“This experience is the highest evidence of the divine authorship of the Bible. We receive God’s word as food for the soul, through the same evidence by which we receive bread as food for the body. Bread supplies the need of our nature; we know by experience that it produces blood and bone and brain. Apply the same test to the Bible; when its principles have actually become the elements of character, what has been the result? What changes

have been made in the life? *‘Old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new’* (II Corinthians 5:17). In its power, men and women have broken the chains of sinful habit. They have renounced selfishness. The profane have become reverent, the drunken sober, the profligate pure. Souls that have borne the likeness of Satan have been transformed into the image of God. This change is itself the miracle of miracles. A change wrought by the word, it is one of the deepest mysteries of the word. We cannot understand it; we can only believe, as declared by the Scriptures, it is *‘Christ in you, the hope of glory’* (Colossians 1:27).” (*Education* 171-172)

The Judgment Seat of Christ

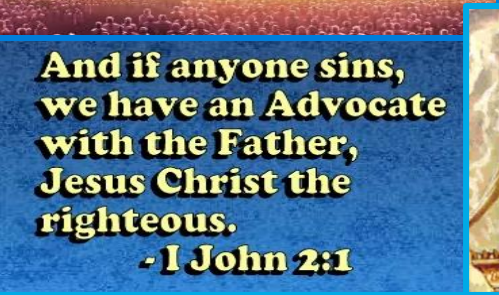

The words of Christ startled the high priest. The thought that there was to be a resurrection of the dead, when all would stand at the bar of God, to be rewarded according to their works, was a thought of terror to Caiaphas. He did not wish to believe that in future he would receive sentence according to his works. {Next Slide Please}
